Assistant District Attorney James Dunn Announces Campaign for State Court Judge

(CUMMING) – Assistant District Attorney James Dunn announced Monday his candidacy for State Court Judge. The nonpartisan election is scheduled to be held May 24, 2022.

“Forsyth County needs a strong, experienced prosecutor and accomplished litigator to keep our county safe, and to be fair and impartial in civil matters,” said Dunn. “I have dedicated my entire legal career to public service and I want to continue to serve the citizens of Forsyth County.”

James Dunn has served as an Assistant District Attorney for Forsyth County since 2002. He is a lead prosecutor and the sole prosecutor for the Johns Creek Forsyth Drug and Gang Taskforce.

“Crime is rising across Metro Atlanta, and it’s important we have a judge that is experienced in the courtroom. I have personally managed and litigated thousands of cases, and I will rely on that experience to keep cases moving quickly and deliver justice.”

Dunn received his bachelor’s degree from the University of Georgia and his law degree from Mercer University. He serves as a board member at Bald Ridge Lodge and is a 2019 graduate of Leadership Forsyth. Prior to serving as an Assistant District Attorney, Dunn served as a law clerk in the Cobb Judicial Circuit.

Dunn lives in Cumming with his wife, Heather, and has four children. They are active members of The Church of Good Shepherd Catholic Church.
